**Hello my friends,**

As I'm sure that you are aware, the morning service for Yom Kippur falls on Saturday, September 30, 2017 this year. That is also the morning that Fort-4-Fitness will be held. As in past years, this event will essentially shut-down the neighborhood surrounding the Temple. In addressing this issue, and working with Deputy Chief Bender and the Fort-4-Fitness folks, we believe that we have a solution to the problem of access for the Temple Membership to attend the service.

*We are requesting that all members attending the service arrive through the intersection of Rudisill/Old Mill, near the entrance of Foster Park. You will be given access to Old Mill moving south to Pettit. At Pettit, the officers working at that location will work you through the gaps in runners to allow you to get to the Temple.*

Enclosed you will find a very bright piece of paper. PLEASE have this paper with you or you will not be able to get through. We will be informing the officers working in this area of the issue and the solution at our squad meeting that morning, so they will be aware of the arrangement. We suggest that you place the paper on the dashboard of your vehicle.

At this time, I don't believe that there will be any issues in leaving after the service is complete. In my experience, the runners/walkers using that part of the course are well north of the Temple and the roads are opened back up.

If you have any questions, please feel free to approach me during the Rosh Hashanah Services. I will be providing security on both days.
