

Cemetery Plots In The Y and YY Section At Lindenwood Cemetery

Frequently Asked Questions

- 1. Who is eligible to purchase a burial plot in the Temple's Y and YY sections at Lindenwood Cemetery? Temple members in good standing are entitled to purchase a grave or graves in the Cemetery for use by the member or the member's spouse, children, or parents. Purchasing a plot is a benefit of membership and only members may buy a plot.
- 2. Who may be buried in the plot? Burial in any grave is restricted to the member/purchaser and the member's spouse, children, children's spouses, parents, and unmarried siblings.
- 3. **How much does a plot cost?** The price of a plot, including the land and perpetual maintenance, is \$2,200.
- 4. Does the deceased need to be Jewish to be buried in the Temple section? Non-Jews may be buried in the Temple section.
- 5. Does the deceased need to be a Temple member at the time of death to use the plot? No.
- 6. Are there other Jewish burial grounds in Fort Wayne? Yes. The Fort Wayne Jewish Cemetery on Decatur Road sells plots and is not affiliated with a congregation. Only Jews may be buried there.

Yahrzeit Plaques at the Temple -

- 1. Who may purchase a yahrzeit plaque? Temple members and non-members may purchase a yahrzeit plaque in memory of a loved one.
- 2. How much is a yahrzeit plaque? The price is \$500.
- **3. Where does the money go?** Proceeds from yahrzeit plaques go to the Temple's Endowment.
- 4. When are yahrzeit plaques dedicated? Yahrzeit plaques are dedicated during the Memorial Service on Yom Kippur.
- 5. When are the lights on individual yahrzeit plaques illuminated? On the individual's yahrzeit and on Yom Kippur.
